
## **The Communication Game**

**Instructions:** Print and cut the scenarios into strips. Place the scenarios into a bowl/bag. Each person takes turns reaching in and reading the scenario they picked. As a group discuss what you would say or do about each scenario. Best to play with smaller groups (4-12 people). Best for people in grades 7-12.





You and your partner are at a party and they are drunk. They want to fool around. What do you do/say?

Your partner tells you oral sex does not count as sex. What do you say?

Your partner tells you they would like to wait until marriage to have sex. What do you say?

A person at a party tells you they will fool around with you as long as you don't tell anyone. What do you say?

You have decided you are not ready to have sex, but your partner keeps pressuring you. What do you do?

You and your partner decide together that you are both ready to have sex. Your partner says there is no need for condoms when birth control is being used. What do you say?

You like a person at school and want to ask them out. How do you do this?

You would like to break up with your partner. They have not done anything wrong; you just don't like them anymore. How do you do this?

You and your friend like the same person. What do you do?

A person you like asks you out, but your friends say they are a slut. What do you do?

You are dating a person and you really like them. They don't want to fool around. Your friends say you should dump them. What do you do?



Your friends are talking about how uncool it is to be a virgin. You are a virgin. What do you say?

You have been dating your partner for four months and you would like them to meet your family. They refuse. What do you do/say?

You and your partner have been dating for 6 months and a pregnancy occurs. What do you do/say?

The person you have been dating tells you they do not want to date you anymore over a text message. How do you react?

Your parents ask if you are dating anyone. What do you say?
