

Part-Time Sexual Health Educator (Canada Summer Jobs Program)

Job Description

This position provides key support to our education team, and helps to deliver comprehensive sexual health education in Waterloo Region. This is a part-time (14 hours per week) contract for 23 weeks.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Help deliver engaging and interactive sexual and reproductive health workshops and trainings for people of all ages (both online and in-person)
- Co-facilitate groups in schools and community spaces
- Develop educational resources for social media, as well as physical resources, including but not limited to videos, infographics, other social media posts, pamphlets, guides, giveaway materials
- Participate in education related projects and research as needed
- Evaluate programs and workshops, incorporating feedback into future sessions
- Track statistics related to all groups and programs in a timely manner
- Maintain an up-to-date knowledge of available community resources and programs
- Participate in regular staff and team meetings
- Participate in work planning processes and tasks which advance the SHORE Centre Strategic Plan
- Work collaboratively with all education staff as well as with broader SHORE team where appropriate
- Adhere to all SHORE Centre policies and procedures
- Other duties as assigned

Qualifications

- **As this is a Canada Summer Jobs funded position- applicants must be between the ages of 15 and 30**
- Committed to SHORE Centre's mission, vision, and values and to building an inclusive workspace, including striving to be anti-racist, accessible, LGBTQ2S positive, aware of class dynamics and power/privilege
- Explicitly support choice and reproductive rights
- Knowledge of topics related to sexual health including but not limited to: consent, healthy relationships, STIs, abortion, birth control, puberty, pornography, pregnancy, safer sex, boundaries, communication
- Experience with workshop and/or group facilitation is an asset
- Exceptional time management and organization skills
- Exceptional communication skills
- High ethical standards and strict adherence to confidentiality

- Clear professional boundaries
- Ability to apply work on a team as well as independently
- Excellent initiative and self-motivation skills
- Experience and interest in creating and editing video content is an asset

Working Conditions

Regular office hours are 9:00-4:30 with a half hour unpaid lunch. Some flexibility is required for after-hours workshops, however there will be advance notice. This is a part-time (14 hours per week) position for 23 weeks.

This position requires long periods of sitting, although there are opportunities to stand and stretch. There are also long periods of focused attention as well as significant use of screens for virtual workshops.

Currently, we are working primarily from home. This position may at times be able to work from our Kitchener office. Our office is on the first floor of an accessible building and we have an in-suite accessible washroom. We are a low/no scent environment however we use cleaning agents regularly for our in-house clinic. This position also requires travelling within Waterloo Region for in-person workshops and groups (when it is safe to do so under COVID restrictions).

Staff will be compensated at an hourly rate of \$16.35 per hour.
