SHORE Centre Service Update

For more than 50 years, SHORE Centre has adapted to meet the changing needs of our community.

Today, we're facing another period of change.

After many months of responding to funding reductions, funding delays, and increasing demand for our services, SHORE has made the difficult decision to temporarily pause our Education, Peer Support, and Counselling programs while we focus on strengthening the organization's long-term sustainability.

This is a temporary change. Our goal is to begin restoring these programs this fall as our financial position allows.

Our Clinic Remains Open

Our clinical services continue without interruption.

Services continuing include:

- Medication abortion care
- Contraception consultations and prescriptions
- IUD and Nexplanon services
- Pap tests
- STI testing and treatment
- Pregnancy testing
- Pregnancy options counselling
- Gender-affirming care

What Has Changed?

Temporarily paused:

- Education Programs
- Peer Support Programs (including Stork Secrets)
- Counselling Services

We are not accepting new referrals, registrations, or workshop bookings. If you are currently connected with one of these programs, a member of our team will contact you directly if your services are affected.



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Why Is This Happening?

Like many community organizations, SHORE has experienced increasing financial pressures while demand for our services continues to grow.

Over the past year, we've strengthened our financial systems, expanded fundraising, reduced expenses where we responsibly could, and carefully reviewed every part of the organization.

These temporary program pauses are intended to protect SHORE's long-term future while ensuring essential clinical services remain available.

Looking Ahead

These programs are an essential part of SHORE. This pause is not a reflection of their importance.

Our goal is to bring these programs back as soon as it is financially responsible to do so.

For more than 50 years, SHORE has adapted to changing community needs and changing funding realities. We're committed to doing so again.
